. Charity Appeal Drive

Once again we were busily involved with the Annual Charity Appeal Drive. This year State celebrated its 62nd appeal which had been running from Oct.1 to Dec.16, 2023. In addition to online-sales, as in the last few years, we had been able to use a handheld combination printer and credit/debt card payment device. It was able to immediately print out tickets on the spot, even if the buyer pays with cash. What a difference this unit has made!! At the end of the drive, we were able to sell \$8,140 worth of tickets through the printer, and \$1,160 through the online program, for a total of \$9,300. This represents an increase of sales of well over 1000% over last year's and has achieved for us a proud 232.5% of our original allotted goal. In addition, our efforts have gained us number 12 ranking in overall State sales. For eight weeks, six days a week, and about seven hours a day, nine members of our Council were selling tickets in Country Club Mall. Our most hearty 'thank you' to the following Brothers who stepped forward and gave so generously of their time: Eduardo Dagsaan, Hans Fadum, Louis Curti, Tony Bucar, Ed Campbell, Greg Large, Randy Wilkes, Garnet Gauthier, and Dan Bossert. Our very special thanks goes out to Bros. Tony and Randy who so very efficiently organized and managed the whole project, in spite of facing a number of very substantial challenges, especially those related to the use and management of the printer/payment device. They, in fact, spent at least 40 hours more than any one else! We also gratefully acknowledge and thank the management of Country Club for providing us space in their mall. Without that generous support we could never have accomplished what we did! Again, thank you one and all!!
