March for Life, May 9, 2019, Victoria, B.C.

Under the sponsorship of our State Council and other organizations, the **12th Annual March for Life, Victoria**, is planned for **May 9, 2019** in Victoria. This year's national theme will be "**50 YEARS OF ABORTION. WHAT'S MISSING ?**" — referring to May 14, 1969 when abortion access was legalized to accredited hospitals. Later, in 1988 the R.v.s. Morgentaler decision abolished Canada's existing abortion laws. Currently, plans for the event will be much like last year: it will begin with Mass at St. Andrew's Cathedral and St. Patrick's Church at 12:00 pm. The march from Centennial Square to the Legislature begins at **1:45 pm** and a rally at the Legislature at **2:15 pm** with various entertainment and speakers. Both our State Council and Bishop **Gary Gordon** have very strongly endorsed this event and invite all Brother Knights, along with their families and friends, to come out and join the march. Our Worthy State Culture of Life Director, Bro. **Edgar Ursua**, writes: "*Brother Knights, I urge all of us to join the march to give witness to our strong commitment to the Pro-Life Movement. Most of our Supreme Officers led by Worthy Supreme Knight **Carl A. Anderson** and their wives join the Annual March for Life in Washington, D.C., an inspiration and commitment that we may follow.*" Hence, it is very important that we as Knights, don't just talk the talk, but now, also walk the walk.
