March for Life, May 13, 2010, Victoria, B.C.

Approximately 1800 people gathered on a sunny spring day in Victoria, BC for the **3rd Annual Western Canada "March for Life"**. Organized by our State Council and supported by various Pro-Life groups from throughout the province, this year's event, building on previous years' successes, turned out even bigger and better. The day began at 12:00 noon at St. Andrew's Cathedral with a Mass presided by our own Bishop **Richard Gagnon**, and concelebrated by Archbishop **Michael Miller** of Vancouver, Bishop **David Munroe** of Kamloops (State Chaplain), and about 18 priests. With the cathedral absolutely filled to overflowing, it was an incredibly moving spiritual experience of prayer, unity and common purpose. The marchers assembled at Centennial Square, and from there began their trek at 2:00 pm with banners and hundreds of "We choose life" posters being carried by Knights and their families. The march stretched well over four blocks in length, took about 30 minutes to reach the Legislature, and included men, women and children from all walks of life and from many corners of our province.
