
Book on Canadian Knights in Action



Dear Brothers Knights,

October is the month of the rosary. Saint John Paul II said that the rosary was his favourite prayer. The rosary is a contemplative and vocal prayer. But as John Paul II said, the heart of the rosary is contemplation. We do pray the Hail Marys and the Our Fathers, but I always remember what one of my teachers said in the seminary: these prayers are meant to be the background music so that we can enter into the life of Jesus and Mary.


