they began, and have continued to the present, to offer scholarships to deserving students continuing their education; for some 25 years they supported the "7-10 Club" both financially and with willing hands. In the 1980s they began a mission fund for "The Little Schools of Father Bohnen" in Haiti, a fund which still continues today as "Pennies for Heaven" where change is collected at each general meeting for this purpose. They were actively involved in the Diocesan Synod and were introduced to prayerful discernment as a means of reaching decisions. Through the 90s and early 2000s they continued faithfully the many ministries handed down to them through the years; they continued generous financial support to the parish by donating funds for "The Annunciation" window in the church and for the kitchen renovations and expansion. During the last ten years the C.W.L began an active Prayer Shawl Ministry. Prayer shawls are made and offered, free of charge, to anyone needing prayer. To date 268 shawls have been made and given away, some going as far as Ontario, the Philippines, England and Ireland. In 2010 the Bereavement Ministry was reinstated to support families arranging a funeral service. Over the years, the Council has hosted Diocesan and Provincial Council conventions, and is honoured to do so again in 2019. As well, some members have and are currently holding both Diocesan and Provincial Council offices. Today, St. Peter's Catholic Women's League is a group of 120 ladies who continue to work together for God and Canada with love and support for each other.

A Proud History of Service to Church and Canada

On October 21st 2017, **St. Peter's Catholic Women's League** will be celebrating 80 years of service to God and Canada.

During the early 1900's there was a concern for the influx of immigrants to the New World - especially for the many young women who were destined for domestic service and needed assistance to establish themselves. The Federal Minister of Reconstruction and Immigration approached the Catholic Church for help. On June 17th 1920 the fledgling **Catholic Women's League of Canada** was founded under the patronage of the hierarchy of Canada and was granted federal incorporation on December 12, 1923.

St. Peter's Catholic Women's League council was organized and chartered fourteen years later in 1937 with 41 ladies and **Fr. MacLellan** as Spiritual Director. The election of officers was conducted by drawing each name from a hat! One of the very first decisions by the first council was to create an envelope system to help pay the debt on the rectory. Then they purchased a bingo set of 50 cards and bingo became one of the main fundraiser for the church and rectory for years and years to come, right into the 1970s. In addition, the ladies raised money catering banquets, creating and selling cookbooks, running rummage sales, etc. The 1960s and '70s were years of tremendous activity for the ladies of the League: they were very involved in the building of the new church, serving food throughout the night while the men were pouring cement for the foundation; they took over the \$32,000 mortgage still owing on the church in 1967 and were successful in paying it off the following year; they adopted a poor family in India and have continued this ministry with a second family to this very day; going through the growing pains of Vatican II they became very involved in all parish ministries;
